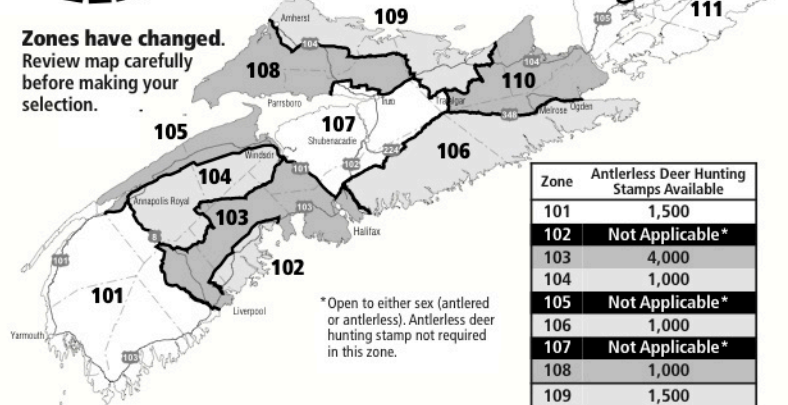

This Fall, 11,500 Antlerless Deer Hunting Stamps are available through a random draw system. Applications will be accepted from 7:00 am Monday July 26th to midnight Friday September 10th, 2010.

Zones have changed. Review map carefully before making your selection.



Hunters in Zone 102 may purchase a Bonus Antlerless Deer Hunting Stamp (entitles the bearer to take an additional antlerless deer) for \$5.00 plus HST

How To Apply:

1. Choose where you want to hunt by selecting a Deer Management Zone.
2. Have your Wildlife Resources Card in hand.
3. You may apply only once. Apply by phone OR online:
 - **By Phone:** Call 1-900-565-3337. Lines are open 24 hours a day. You will be charged \$7.25 plus HST to apply. Calls cannot be made using a cell phone and charges cannot be billed to another phone number.
 - **Online:** Apply with a credit card online at <https://www.gov.ns.ca/natr/draws/deerdraw/> The fee is the same as a telephone application.

Draw Results: A computerized random draw will occur on Saturday September 11th, 2010. Winners will be notified by mail. Applicants can check their individual draw results:

- Online at <https://www.gov.ns.ca/natr/draws/deerdraw/> beginning September 13th.
- By phone at 1-877-535-1234. The line will operate for one week beginning September 18th at 7:00 am.

Reminders:

- Applicants must be Nova Scotia residents and be eligible to hold a 2010 Resident Deer Hunting Licence.
- You may apply only once.
- Antlerless Deer Hunting Stamps are not transferrable or refundable.
- Consult the 2010 Hunting and Furharvesting Licence and Summary of Regulations booklet or visit www.gov.ns.ca/natr/hunt/regulations for full details about hunting deer in Nova Scotia.

ATTENTION Seasonal Tourism Businesses

If you own a seasonal tourist business you may be eligible to pay property taxes at 75% of the municipal commercial tax rate.

A seasonal tourist business is

- a restaurant, a roofed accommodation (hotel, motel, inn), or a campground
- closed for at least four months in the taxation year (April 1 to March 31). It is no longer necessary that the months be consecutive.

In order to be eligible for the reduced commercial tax rate, property owners must apply **each year** and demonstrate that their seasonally operated tourist business meets the criteria outlined in the application form.

The deadline for receiving applications is September 1.

Applications are available at www.pvsc.ca or can be picked up at any Property Valuation Services Corporation (PVSC) Office, Access Nova Scotia, or by calling 1-800-380-7775.
