Ms. MacKinnon attributes the cooperation on a large scale as the source of the initiative's success. "There was much more interest in the project on a community level with workshops among themselves as well as an Island wide introduction to social media for the operators." Ms. MacKinnon sees this as the beginning of building more relationships with other parts of Cape Breton.

Overall the Top of the Island social media initiative members saw an increase in visitors and sales of some 12%.

Not bad, Ms. MacKinnon figures when the rest of the province, if they saw any increases at all, topped out at 4%.

"We will continue to work with all members of the Top of the Island initiative to get them to use Facebook and Twitter regularly so they can cross reference with each other. With our attractions and activities we can get people to stay longer."

Terri McCulloch, from Bay of Fundy Tourism, which represents the area's successful bid to become one of the modern 7 wonders of the world finalists, explained that social media is basically people having a conversation with people.

Ms. McCulloch presented figures which show that 70% of Canadians use some form of social media to have a conversation.
